Araki received his Bachelor of Fine Arts in Sculpture from <u>Sam Fox School of Design & Visual</u> <u>Arts at Washington University in St. Louis</u>, U.S.A. in 2007, and completed his <u>Master of Film</u> <u>and New Media Studies from Tokyo University of the Arts</u> in 2010. In 2013, he was selected to participate in <u>Tacita Dean Workshop hosted by Fundación Botín</u> in Santander, Spain. During 2017-8, he was a guest resident at <u>Asia Culture Center</u> in Gwangju, South Korea, and <u>Rijksakademie van beeldende kunsten</u> in Amsterdam, the Netherlands. In 2019, he joined a retreat hosted by <u>MAIX (Malaysian Artist Intention Experiment</u>) which took place in the jungle of Perak State, Malaysia.
